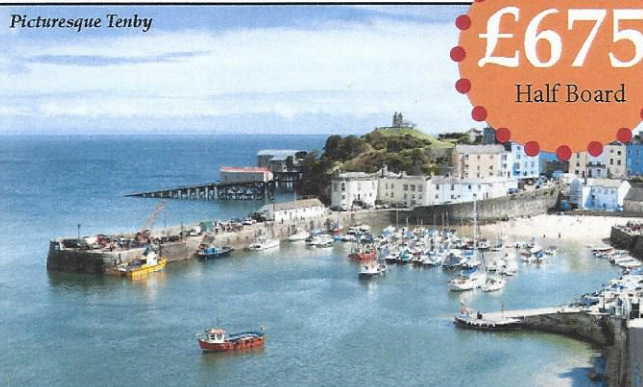
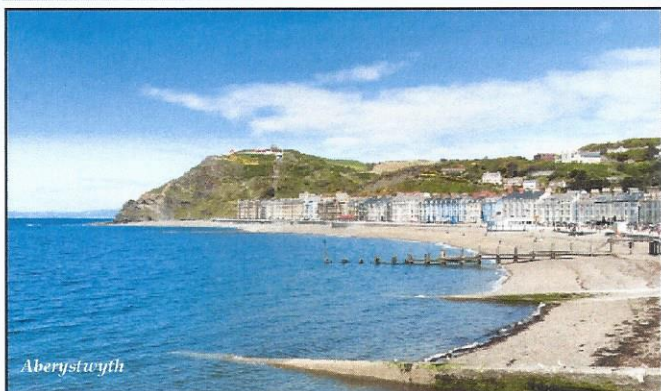

Other holiday highlights include a visit to the wonderful **Picton Castle Gardens**.

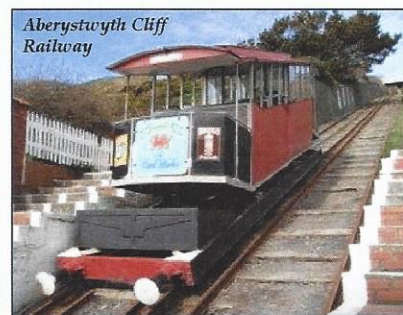
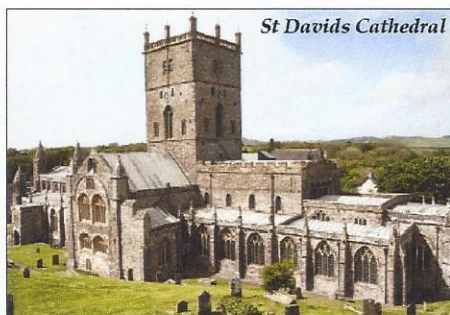
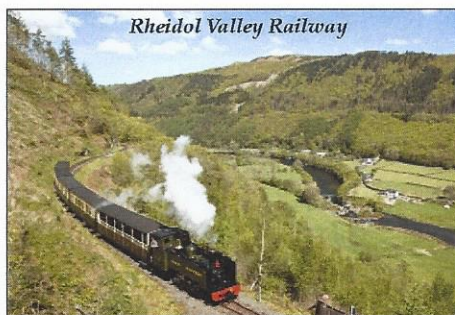

Rest assured the Gwbert offers a very high level of comfort while taking full advantage of the wonderful views from its restaurant, terrace and some of the bedrooms.

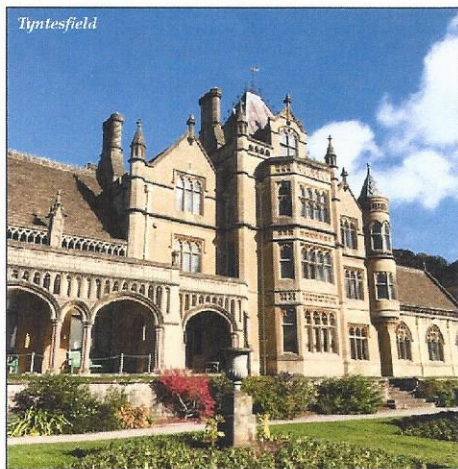




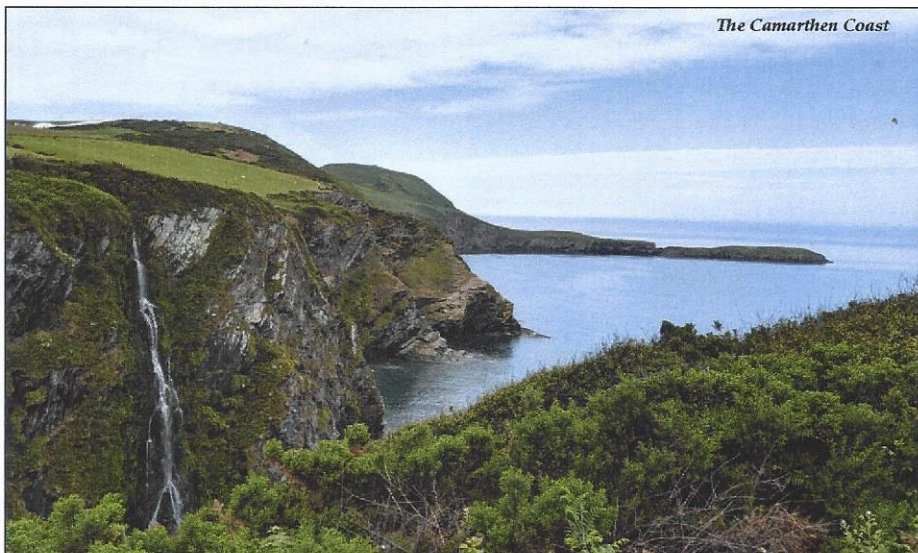

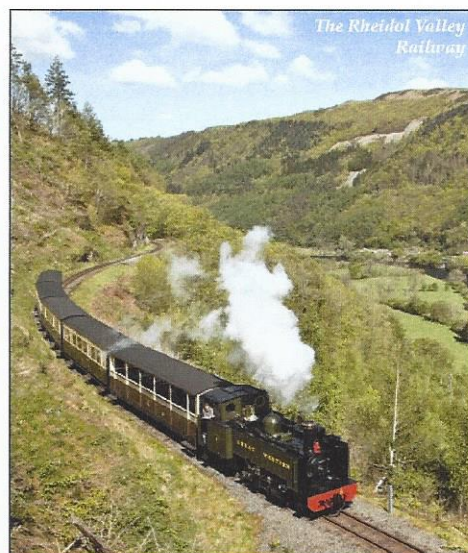

## THE ITINERARY

**Monday** - After leaving Lymington at 09.00 the group starts the journey to Wales and the **Gwbert Hotel** which is situated overlooking **Cardigan Bay**. En route there will be a couple of comfort stops, one on the motorway and then to visit the **remarkable Dewstow Gardens & Grottoes**.

**Tuesday** - Keeping things relaxed, and subject to good weather, the morning features a visit to **Picton Castle Gardens**, after which everyone will rejoin the coach and drive to charming **St David's**, our smallest Cathedral City. Here there will be free time to visit the cathedral which occupies a site with a history of Christian worship dating back 1500 years and that many people, Christians and non-Christians alike, believe has a unique spiritual atmosphere. Anyone who prefers to relax at the hotel will be dropped off first. The coach will aim to return to the hotel by mid-late afternoon.

**Wednesday** - Today the coach heads northwards along the coast to **Aberystwyth**. On arrival there will be some free time for sightseeing and lunch, with one option being a ride on the resort's remarkable **Victorian Cliff Railway**, the highest cliff railway in the UK. The coach will leave Aberystwyth after lunch when there will be the opportunity to take a trip on the scenic **Rheidol Valley Railway**. Those who don't want to join in on the train ride can follow on the coach. The coach will return to the hotel by late afternoon.

**Thursday** - The programme today a visit **picturesque harbour town of Tenby**. Here there will be time wander around the old port which offers a great choice of restaurants, cafes and independent type shops, with a further option being to take a boat trip to visit the **Caldey Island** which is home one of the largest monasteries in Wales. The coach will aim to return to the hotel by mid-late afternoon.

**Friday** - Departing the hotel after breakfast and start the homeward journey stopping for an extended lunch break at the **National Trust's Tyntesfield**, just south of Bristol. The expected time of arrival back at the departure points is 17.30 & 18.30.

PLEASE NOTE
1) The cost of the holiday is £675 per person. To confirm your booking you need to complete the booking form and send it via the post or email to Steve Mitchell of Mitchellwood Travel Ltd. You also need to pay a non-refundable deposit of £100 per person and you can either send a cheque, made payable to Mitchellwood Travel Ltd, or pay via internet banking.
2) Deposits - Please send your completed booking form and a deposit cheque for £100 per person to Steve Mitchell of Mitchellwood Travel at the address below. Please make your cheque payable to Mitchellwood Travel Ltd. If you would prefer to pay by bank transfer, please tick the box on the left hand side and we will send you the appropriate bank details.
3) Payments by card - We do not accept payment by card, largely due to the high commission charged by the banks (approx. £15pp on a tour like this one). However, please be reassured that all payments made to Mitchellwood are protected by Financial Failure Insurance - see reverse side.
4) Travel insurance - See reverse side. Although we recommend taking out travel insurance, and having adequate travel insurance a conditional of travel on our overseas tours, with this being a UK holiday the choice is yours. The main purpose of travel insurance in this case would be to cover the risk of you having to cancel your holiday, or if for some reason you missed the departure.
5) Room types - The hotel only has 21 rooms and the group has 17 rooms of those on its current allocation. This includes a maximum of six doubles for single occupancy. Rooms will be allocated on a strictly first come first served basis, so please do not delay booking.
6) Sea Views - Some of the twin rooms, including 3 of our up-graded rooms offer sea views. As shown in the panel to the left, a supplement applies for these rooms
7) No lift in the hotel - Please be aware that the hotel does not have a lift and that steps divide certain areas of the hotel.
8) National Trust (NT) - As we expect the majority of passengers will be National Trust members entrances are not included in the tour price. Non-members will have the cost of entry to added to the final balance invoices. Entry to Tyntesfield was £17 in 2023, but it is likely to be higher in 2024.
9) Final balance invoices will be sent out in early March for payment before the 19th March 2024.
10) Joining instructions and luggage labels will be sent to you 2-3 weeks before departure. Portage at the hotel is included in the tour price.
